



The Salamanca hospital fell to third position in the Hospital Excellence Index

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The Río Hortega University Hospital in Valladolid maintains its position as the best center in Castilla y León according to the Hospital Excellence Index (IEH) conducted by the Coordinated Institute of Governance and Applied Economics (ICGEA), which places the Salamanca hospital center in third . position.

The next positions of the IEH Castilla y León 2023 for the Hospital Clínico Universitario de Valladolid, which has improved by one position compared to the previous edition, leaves the third place for the Hospital Universitario de Salamanca, according to Europa Press.

León Healthcare Complex is in fourth place and Burgos University Hospital, in fifth, maintaining their 2022 position.

2023 is the eighth year that ICGEA publishes its IEH ranking and where it once again confirms the leadership of the Jiménez Díaz Foundation as the best hospital in Spain, whose 'outstanding performance, commitment to excellence and highly qualified management, endorsed by success. of the great achievements that have shaped its trajectory, as well as the data continuously published in the sector, which show that it has fewer waiting lists compared to other hospitals, has been the key to maintaining its position in leadership for the past eight years. «, according to Jesús Sánchez Lambás, executive vice president of ICGEA.

The General and Autonomous IEH stands as a health thermometer that annually measures the level of excellence of the country's hospital centers, which is shown, among other aspects, by its qualified staff, which includes some of the best who are doctors and specialists in Europe. ; significant investment in hospital infrastructure and medical technology; high level of science; the way in which patient care is approached, with an increasing

emphasis on human care; and, also, due to the widespread accessibility characteristic of the Spanish health system.

In general terms, the IEH 2023 confirms the strength of the health of the Community of Madrid "by leading the first three positions in the national top 10" with three regional centers. These are the Fundación Jiménez Díaz and La Paz university hospitals, which maintained their positions compared to last year, and the Gregorio Marañón, which gained a place by moving from the fourth to the third position.

The fourth and fifth positions were completed in Catalonia, with the Hospital Clínic Barcelona (4th) – which lost one place – and the Vall d'Hebron University Hospital, in the fifth position, so it gained one.

The following are for Hospital Ruber Internacional (6th) -which this year rose by one position-, and Hospital Clínico San Carlos (7th) -which lost two-. The eighth goes to the only center in Valencia that is in the top 10, the Hospital Universitari i Politècnic La Fe (8th) -which gained one place compared to 2022-.

One of the main innovations is that Catalonia once again included Teknon Medical Center (9th) in the IEH 2023 General, leaving Quirónsalud Barcelona Hospital (10th) in tenth position.

The IEH 2023 shows, after covid19, that the continued commitment of Spanish centers to maintain the highest standards of hospital quality "is indisputable, surpassing the European average."
